This is not a highly educated individual. The movement pattern is shaky and uneven, which suggests that the person may have taken medication at the time of the writing.

The lower zone is extended and slants toward the right of the page, indicating the influence of the writer's mother. The lower zone also represents instincts, excessive appetites and materialism. This writing shows a great deal of fantasy and sensuality.

The spatial arrangement on the page is good, showing ability to function. There's irregularity in the formation of the letters, as well as variability in the baseline, indicating volatility of mood. The writer resists the routine of habits and rules. (That is, unless he makes them himself!)

Brought up in a conservative environment, the writer is seeking affection and nurturing, and perhaps felt these qualities lacking from his parents, although the pattern reveals the strong presence of his mother.


The writing connection and slant of the letters show a great need to accomplish and prove himself, but always on his own terms. The upper zone is prevalent and reveals his ambition, aspiration and fantasy. The writing lacks a firm structure, a clue to the author being easily influenced by his environment.

The upper zones of the capital "I's" are circular, showing, again, his fantasies and self-involvement. The writing pattern reveals potential that was realized or cultivated by the writer.

The shape and slackness of the letters indicate a willingness to experiment, broad versatility, and a desire to explore and test new options and opportunities.

The writer's self-awareness and self-regulation are weak and the pattern on the page is full of emotion. His impulsivity is somewhat contained by the connectedness of the letters, which shows a desire for self-control. It holds the writing together and reveals an underlying willingness to persevere with his abundant creative fantasies and abilities.

The pattern, while uneven, is filled with enthusiasm. This is someone who has potential, but is looking for opportunities to receive both relaxation and stimulation outside of himself. His reach may, in fact, exceed his grasp.
